- ◆ Submit one form per incident and include case number.
- ◆ When there are multiple weapon or injury codes, indicate only the most serious.
- ◆ Record all offenses occurring in an incident.
- ◆ Utilize the I-UCR Offense Code Sheet (1/02).

Domestic related includes family or household members which includes spouses, former spouses, parents, children, stepchildren and other persons related by blood or marriage, persons who share or formerly shared a common dwelling and persons who have or allegedly have a child in common. In the case of a high-risk adult with disabilities, family or household member includes any person who has the responsibility for a high-risk adult as a result of a family relationship or who has assumed responsibility for all or a portion of the care of a high-risk adult with disabilities voluntarily, or by express or implied contract, or court order.

Attacks against school personnel include teachers, administrative personnel or educational support personnel.

Hate Crime Incident Report

General Instructions

The Hate Crime Incident Report should be used to report initially a hate-related incident or to adjust information in a previously reported incident.

- ◆ Submit one form per incident and include an identifying incident number which will be your ‘case’ or ‘file’ number.

Provide codes for all offenses within the incident determined to be hate-related and the number of victims for each such offense. In multiple offense incidents, report only those offenses determined to be hate-related.

- ◆ Record the two digit offense code indicated on the form and the total number of victims.
- ◆ Indicate up to six offenses for each incident.
- ◆ Indicate only one location for each incident.
- ◆ Indicate only one bias motivation per incident.
- ◆ Indicate each victim type corresponding to each offense identified within the hate-related incident.
- ◆ Where the victim type is an ‘individual,’ indicate the total number of individual victims involved in the incident irrespective of the number of offenses in which they were involved.
- ◆ Indicate the total number of offenders involved in the incident, if unknown, report that such is unknown.
- ◆ Provide the suspected offender’s race, if known. If there was more than one offender, provide the race of the group as a whole.
