

DIVISION OF INTERNAL INVESTIGATION

2021 ANNUAL STATISTICAL REPORT

In 2021, the Division of Internal Investigation (DII) opened 146 cases of Illinois State Police employee misconduct. In 55 investigations completed by DII, 8 employees received discipline and of those 2 resigned prior to discipline being served, 3 were exonerated, 6 were not sustained, 1 was administratively closed, 4 were unfounded and 33 cases are still open. Cases of less serious transgressions (91) were referred to the employee's division to investigate.

In 2021, DII opened 61 cases of employee misconduct reported by other agencies under the purview of the Governor. Of those cases investigated by DII, 2 were convictions, 1 was exonerated, 1 was dismissed, 3 were administratively closed, 8 were declined by the prosecutor, 8 were not sustained and 1 was unfounded. There are 37 cases still open.

In 2021, 649 background investigations were completed for ISP applicants and for criminal justice agencies under the Governor's purview. An additional 114 criminal history checks were completed for the ISP and criminal justice agencies.
